IELTS Exam Format



SPEAKING

(Time: 11 - 14 minutes)

A face-to-face interview comprised of three sections: short questions, speaking at length about a familiar topic and a structured discussion. The Speaking test in IELTS on Computer is scheduled in the same day as your written test. It may be taken in the morning or in the afternoon and may either be delivered in-person or through video call.



LISTENING

(Time: 30 minutes, plus 10 minute extra to transfer your answer to the sheet in IELTS on paper)

There are four sections, which include both monologues and conversations. A variety of voices and accents are used and each section is played only once.



WRITING

(Time: 60 minutes)

There are two tasks in total. In Task 1, you are presented with a table, graph, chart or diagram and are asked to describe, summarise or explain the information in no less than 150 words. In Task 2, you are asked to write an essay of no less than 250 words in response to a point of view, argument or problem.



READING

(Time: 60 minutes)

There are three long reading passages with tasks. Texts range from descriptive and factual to the discursive and analytical and may include non-verbal material such as diagrams, graphs or illustrations.

Foreign Worker Protections in Australia

Australia's Fair Work Commission (FWC) ensures a level playing field for both local and foreign workers. This means that regardless of your visa status, you're entitled to the same basic protections and benefits as any Australian employee.

Equal Treatment: Workplace laws in Australia apply to all workers employed in the country. This includes minimum pay rates, working hours, leave entitlements, and termination procedures. There's no distinction between foreign and local workers under the Fair Work Act.
